



Assisted Living Requirements

- Residents must be continent of bowel and bladder. Residents must be able to transfer themselves off and on the toilet. Residents who are incontinent must be able to manage their own incontinence by using proper incontinence products, using good hygiene, and disposing of incontinent products properly.
- Residents must be able to be independent with personal hygiene. Staff may oversee personal hygiene but resident must be able to perform activities of personal hygiene such as oral hygiene, nail care, hair care and dressing. Residents must be dressed when in public areas of the facility.
- Residents will receive a bath twice a week, with staff to assist as to provide cleanliness.
- Residents will receive three meals a day and snacks daily and be able to feed self and hydrate self with or without adaptive devices. Residents will be expected to eat their meals in the dining room unless experiencing an acute episode of illness.
- Residents must be independently mobile with or without the use of adaptive equipment such as wheelchairs, canes, walkers, braces, etc.
- Rooms will be cleaned bi-weekly by staff.

If it is determined by the facility administration that the resident cannot meet the above requirements, a plan will be formulated to accommodate the resident's need with assistance and to help find appropriate placement.
